Informed that archery hunting is permitted on private property due to overpopulation of deer. If deer drops on another person's property, the hunter must obtain permission to get the deer. All must follow "in season" laws.

Columbus Police Liaison - Scott Clinger

It is illegal to fire a firearm in the city limits (Combustion through a Barrel).
If you hit a deer, CPD will tag the carcass and contact people from a list who may want the deer.
