NCC Report July 2023

- The city's impound lot is open again so CPD can have illegally parked and/or abandoned cars towed after failure to comply with warnings and tickets. Report illegally parked and/or abandoned cars through the 311 system.
- The City Attorney has negotiated a nuisance abatement agreement with The Doll House (Karl Rd.) that has significant new safety procedure requirements. It remains closed until the agreement requirements have been installed at which time the City Attorney will withdraw the objection to the renewal of the liquor license.
- ODOT has secured funding for Phase 1 of the 161 corridor rebuild plan from Maple Canyon Dr. to Ambleside Dr. Road resurfacing, installation of a multi-use path and sidewalk, and installation of mini-roundabouts will be included. Engineering studies and purchase of additional right of way began in June, projected date for beginning construction is Spring 2026.
- The mayor's Office of Violence Prevention has been established to coordinate the multiple city-run and city funded violence prevention programs and conduct research and policy development to guide the focus of programs where data indicates the need is highest. It will include a web based dashboard for public use.
- The July 4th parade was a success with over 50 registered participants (up from 30 the prior year).
- The Ohio Department of Public Safety, is expanding a program to prevent injuries among older drivers. CarFit is an educational program which offers older adults the opportunity to improve their safety and comfort behind the wheel. At a CarFit event, trained volunteers complete a 12-point checklist with each driver. Occupational therapists are also on hand to provide a consultation, if needed.
