NCC Report November 2023

- Motor vehicle thefts from cars at hotels (especially Morse & 71 and Sunbury and 71) have spiked a lot 4 high caliber rifles stolen from the trunk of one car. Take all valuables out of parked car whether at home or when traveling.
- Homeless camp behind former Wendy's on Busch Blvd. cleared out property owner drove up from Mississippi to evict residents and provide CPD with trespass order. Residents were offered city and non-profit services prior to eviction.
- City Attorney secured nuisance abatement closure order on Baymont Inn on Morse Rd. due to high level of CPD calls for prostitution activity.
- Street widening on Busch Blvd. from 161 will commence Spring 2024. Bike lanes from 161 to Shrock Rd. to Blendon Woods Metro Park will be included. Sidewalks/Shared use paths will not be included. Project information can be found here: https://www.columbus.gov/Templates/Detail.aspx?id=2147526709
